

REMOVAL

- 1. REMOVE INNER REAR VIEW MIRROR
- 2. REMOVE SUN VISORS AND HOLDERS
- 3. REMOVE ASSIST GRIPS
- 4. REMOVE QUARTER TRIM (See page BO-45)
- 5. REMOVE FRONT PILLAR GARNISHES
- 6. REMOVE COWL LOUVER (See page BO-27)
- 7. REMOVE WIPER ARMS (See page BO-27)




8. REMOVE WINDSHIELD OUTSIDE UPPER MOULDING

(a) Using a knife, cut off the moulding, as shown in the illustration.

NOTICE:

Do not damage the body with the knife.


(b) Remove the remaining moulding.



9. REMOVE WINDSHIELD GLASS

- (a) Push piano wire through between the body and glass from the interior.
- (b) Tie both wire ends to a wooden block or similar object. HINT:

Apply protective tape to the outer surface to keep the surface from being scratched.



NOTICE:

When separating the glass, take care not to damage the paint and interior and exterior ornaments. To prevent scratching the safety pad when removing the windshield, place a plastic sheet between the piano wire and safety pad.

- (c) Cut the adhesive by pulling the piano wire around it.
- (d) Remove the glass.

NOTICE:

Leave as much of the adhesive on the body as possible when cutting off the glass.
